## SUMMER READING CLUB FAQs

### *What is the Summer Reading Club (SRC)?*

Children read (independent readers) or are read to each week (family readers), fill out a READO board (reading log), and receive prizes! All children (from baby until 5<sup>th</sup> grade) are invited to join our free program. Families must register each child individually.

### *When does registration for the SRC begin?*

Registration begins on June 21 at the library and the program runs from June 21 until August 17. Registration will take place in the Children's Room.

### *How Much Does the SRC Cost?*

Nothing, it's absolutely free!

### *If Someone Can't Read Yet, can they still participate?*

Absolutely! You can just circle 'Family Reader' on the SRC registration form. You're never too young to join in the fun! Good listening counts for children who have not yet learned to read and there are fun activities too. The 'Family Reader' program is just for you.

### *What will I be doing?*

For Independent Readers: Every week you get an independent reader READO board for you to fill out. You can read a magazine, books from a school reading list, or *any* book that you like! Just follow the directions on the READO board and submit your READO board. The main thing is ... READ!

For Family Readers: Every week you get a family reader READO board for you to fill out. You can read books, sing/learn songs, and participate in fun activities. Just follow the directions on the family reader READO board and hand it in for your prize.

You have until August 30 to hand in all of your READO boards and receive prizes and reading certificates.
